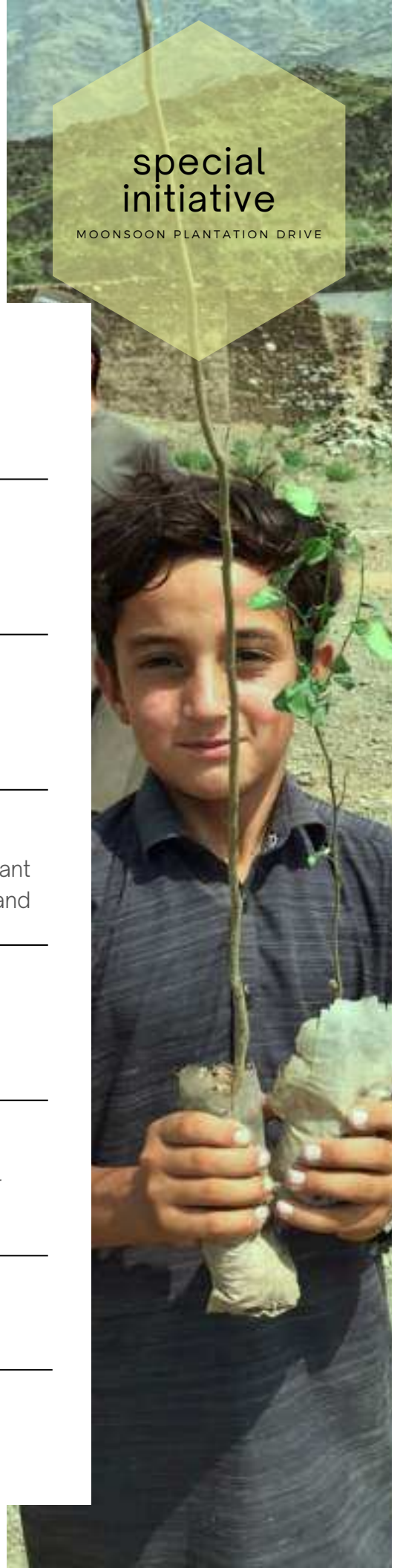

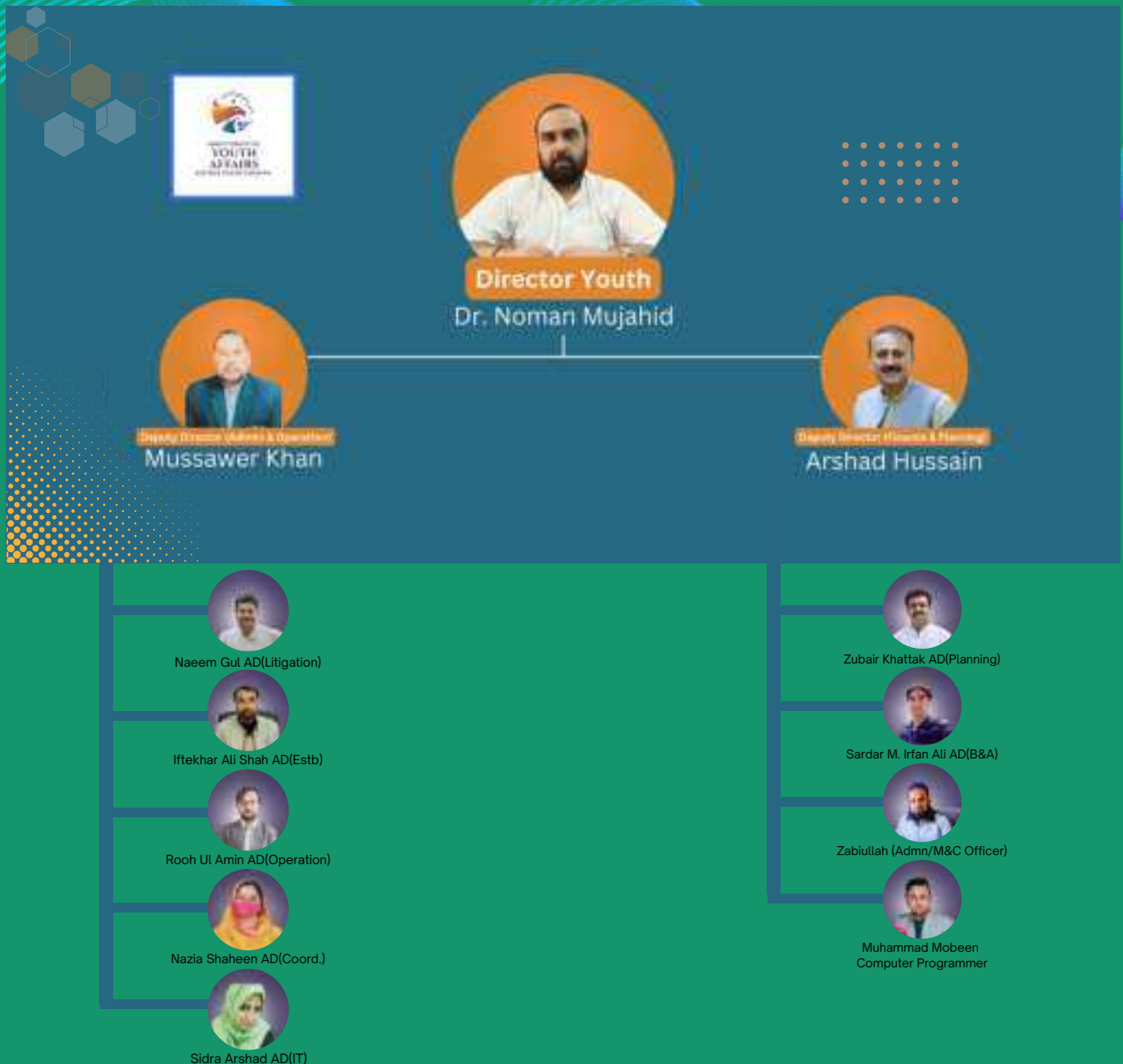

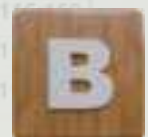
YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE

NEWS FROM CHPRA YOUTH HOSTEL NARAN

The Youth Hostel Chapra Naran recently hosted social work students from the University of Peshawar for a five-day fieldwork experience focused on "Green Social Work: Youth for Climate Justice" in the Kaghan Valley's mountainous communities. This initiative was conducted in collaboration with the Directorate of Youth Affairs, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

The fieldwork, an essential component of social work education, provided students with hands-on experience in agency settings. Under the supervision of experienced faculty members, students explored the following research themes:

- Community Profiling: Socio-economic conditions of local populations (Dr. Imran)
- Tourism's impact on local communities: Socio-economic and cultural conditions (Dr. Imran)
- Climate change and senior citizens in Naran Valley (Ms. Farhana)
- Climate change and child protection issues (Ms. Nasira Nasreen)
- Tourism and substance use among youth (Mr. Faiq Sajjad)
- Climate change and people with disabilities (Dr. Shakeel)

This fieldwork experience enabled students to apply theoretical knowledge in real-world settings, fostering practical skills and a deeper understanding of green social work and climate justice

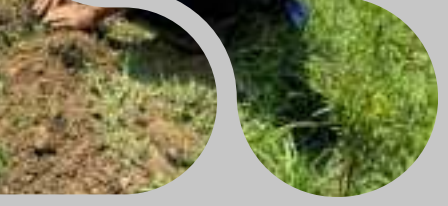
