Ms. Nazoo from Aahung shared the organization's thirty years of experience in delivering LSBE across Pakistan, focusing on their evidence-based approaches, gender-sensitive content, and the measurable impact of their community engagement efforts. Advocate Fayaz Afridi, a lawyer and journalist, delivered an engaging session on effective communication, underscoring its importance in leadership, advocacy, and social interaction, while encouraging participants to practice clarity and confidence in their communication style. Psychologist Ms. Amara Iqbal addressed the growing mental health concerns among youth, offering practical strategies for stress management, emotional resilience, and self-care, and emphasized the importance of seeking timely professional support.
