

Preface

In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the provincial government is dedicated to empowering the youth, considering them as the provincial largest demographic dividend. Since the establishment of the Directorate of Youth Affairs in 2017, a variety of initiatives have been introduced to promote both personal and professional development among youth.

One of the key initiatives, the Ehsaas Naujawan Programme, was launched in November 2024, to offer interest-free loans to entrepreneurs. So far, more than 3569 individuals have been benefited through Akhuwat Islamic Microfinance, and 180 clusters received financial assistance from the Bank of Khyber, helping them turn innovative ideas into viable businesses.

In addition to provision of interest free loans, the government has set up Jawan Marakiz (Youth Centers) in every district. These centers act as hubs for learning, innovation, and community involvement, providing facilities like auditoriums, incubation centers, IT labs, e-libraries, and co-working spaces. A notable highlight is the state-of-the-art Jawan Markiz under construction in District Mohmand, Buner, Swabi, Mardan, Haripur, and DI-Khan, aims to support underprivileged and terrorism-affected communities.

As part of the Youth Development Packages Project, various small-scale activities have been launched across the province. These initiatives include capacity-building programs, vocational training sessions, and entrepreneurial workshops aimed at equipping young individuals with the skills and resources they need to succeed in today's ever-changing environment.

Moreover, the Directorate has taken over key youth hostels to improve accommodation options for young travelers and students. The Youth Hostel Battakundi Naran, Chapra Youth Hostel Naran, and Khanaspur (Ayubia) are now operational, offering affordable lodging in the scenic Naran and Galyat. These hostels provide a comfortable atmosphere that fosters learning and cultural exchange, further aiding the province's youth in their educational and professional journeys.

Through these extensive efforts, the provincial government reaffirms its commitment to foster social economic development of youth of the province..





Under the Summer Camps for Youth in Youth Hostels strategy, various activities were organized, including a Leadership Camp at Batakundi, a Summer School at Iqra University, park reservations, and COMSTECH room bookings. These initiatives collectively benefitted 1,100 youth, including 150 orphans and 950 general youth, promoting inclusive learning and leadership development.







Report on **Jawan Marakiz Status Across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**



District Mohmand

The first-ever Jawan Markaz in District Mohmand is almost complete. This state-of-the-art facility is designed to serve underprivileged and terrorism affected communities, offering the youth opportunities to develop their skills and potential on both national and international levels.



District Swabi: Steady Progress

In Swabi, approximately 40% of the Jawan Markaz construction has been completed. Column erection is in progress, and building materials are adequately stocked on-site.



Grand Youth Complex Peshawar: 70% Complete

Construction on the Grand Youth Complex in Peshawar is 70% complete. This facility will be a central hub for youth activities in the region.



District D.I.Khan: 50% Completed

The construction work of Jawan Markaz D.I. Khan is progressing smoothly, with around 50% of the structure completed. The brick walls and support pillars are already in place, and construction materials are available on-site. The project team is actively working to ensure its timely completion.



District Mardan: Steady Progress

In Mardan, significant progress has been made on the Jawan Markaz construction. Foundation and earth filling have been completed, and beam work on the ground floor is underway. The quality of work has been found satisfactory, showcasing efficient progress within a short timeframe.



Jawan Markaz Development Underway in District Haripur

In District Haripur, work on the Jawan Markaz began at the start of this year with a focus on creating a dynamic space for youth engagement, skill development, and empowerment. Planning and development efforts are underway to ensure the center meets the diverse needs of the youth in the region.



South Waziristan Lower: Work Begins

In South Waziristan Lower, work on the establishment of Jawan Markaz has officially commenced. The center will serve as a hub for youth empowerment, learning, and community engagement.

Orakzai, Khurram and North Waziristan: Land Acquired

Land for Jawan Marakiz in these districts has been acquired. These centers are expected to deliver much-needed infrastructure to empower the youth in these regions.

Temporary and Permanent Jawan Marakiz: Ongoing Progress

Temporary rented buildings are being used to house Jawan Marakiz in some districts while permanent facilities are under construction. Across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, significant progress is being made on permanent Jawan Marakiz, providing hope and empowerment to the youth in these regions.



Expenditure Reported by DYOs









Key Observations







The introduction of the Results for Development (R4D) Framework in 2024–25, aimed to establish a result-oriented approach aligned with the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Youth Policy 2016. It was designed to standardize youth-related activities across all districts and provide a measurable framework to assess performance under the six thematic areas defined in the policy.

Key Observations and Shortfalls: _

- 1. As per the Provincial Finance Commission (PFC) formula, 2.5% of the development budget is to be earmarked for youth. No district has allocated the required funds consistently.
- 2. Several activities were ceremonial in nature with minimal developmental impact.
- 3. The District Youth Officers (DYOs) were appointed in the year 2018 through Public Services Commission; however, no pre-service training was provided. They were posted out in the district without a clear understanding of their core responsibilities, or the necessary knowing of public administration system, project management and financial knowledge.
- 4. Trainings at the District level were not aligned with the six thematic areas of the annual calendar (R4D) framework.
- 5. No centralized M&E system to evaluate training effectiveness, outcomes, or youth satisfaction.

Recommendations

"The Youth sector, being a specialized and technical subject, requires legislative reform to be treated as a provincialized subject. This can be achieved through necessary amendments in the Finance Bill, subject to the approval of the Provincial Cabinet and the Provincial Assembly."

This structural reform is essential for the following reasons:

- 1. Standardization of Activities: Provincialization will ensure uniform implementation of youth initiatives across all districts in line with the KP Youth Policy 2016. Although an Annual Calendar was introduced for the first time in an effort to standardized and improve quality of the training, but the desired results could not be achieved due to limited resources and the shifting priorities of the District Administration.
- 2. Equitable Access for Rural Youth: Devolving the subject to district administrations has led to de-centralized discretion based approach with adhoc handling at the district level. Provincial oversight will guarantee equitable allocation of resources and opportunities for youth in rural and underserved areas.
- 3. Improved Monitoring and Accountability: Presently, there is no effective monitoring mechanism at any level. Activities at the district level are largely conducted at the discretion of Deputy Commissioners (DCs), often lacking strategic direction or alignment with policy objectives. A centralized system would enhance accountability and performance tracking.
- 4. Capacity Building and Technical Support: Youth development requires technically trained staff, structured programming, and evidence-based planning—capabilities which district administrations currently lack. Provincialization will enable specialized support, capacity building, and institutional continuity.
- 5. Policy Cohesion and Long-Term Planning: Retaining youth as a provincial subject allows for long-term policy implementation, integration with other provincial development initiatives, and better coordination with national and international development partners.
- 6. Develop an integrated Youth Management Information System (YMIS) for data collection, analysis, and reporting from all districts.

Recommendations

- 7. Establish a mandatory induction and refresher training programme for all DYOs and district youth staff focused on:
 - Youth development principles
 - Implementation of R4D Framework
 - · Project management and performance monitoring
 - Issue clearly defined Terms of Reference (ToRs) for DYOs.
 - · Conduct a human resource audit to reassess staffing needs and eliminate
- 8. Develop a centralized training curriculum bank aligned with the R4D framework, empanel certified trainers/institutions through a transparent selection process.
- 9. Roll out a digital M&E system with:
 - Pre/post training assessments
 - Attendance verification
 - Participant feedback and impact tracking
 - Set up a training audit unit within the Directorate for quality control.
- 10. Conduct a human resource audit to reassess staffing needs and eliminate redundancy.
- 11. Introduce a performance-based appraisal and incentive system linked with quarterly deliverables.
- 12. Issue a formal notification from the Planning & Development and Finance Departments making the 2.5% allocation mandatory.
- 13. Establish MoUs between the Directorate and district administrations to ensure quarterly reporting on fund utilization.
- 14. Launch a Youth Fund Compliance Dashboard to display real-time district-level compliance.
- 15. Coordinate with Local Government Department to include dedicated youth budget lines in District ADP.



Way Forward

To ensure that the R4D Framework becomes an effective tool for youth empowerment in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, the following strategic shifts are essential:

- 1. From ceremonial to structural reform
- 2. From inconsistent to equitable funding
- 3. From individual to institutional capacity-building
- 4. From passive to participatory planning
- 5. From activity-based to outcome-based performance
