



# ADVISOR TAJ MUHAMMAD TARAND VISITED DIRECTORATE OF YOUTH AFFAIRS

Date: 06.11.2025

The Advisor to the Chief Minister for Sports and Youth Affairs, Taj Muhammad Tarand, visited the Directorate of Youth Affairs, Peshawar, where he inspected various sections and reviewed the department's performance, development projects, and ongoing issues. ## YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS SEMINAR










Venue: IMSciences Peshawar



### **Jawan Marakiz Status**

#### Statement Report on Youth Development Schemes Progress

- The following is a consolidated statement on the financial and physical progress of various youth development schemes:
- Upgradation of Battakundi Youth Hostel (Phase-I) has been completed with 100% financial and physical progress. The total cost of 33.00 has been fully utilized.
- Construction of Peshawar Youth Complex has achieved 64% financial progress (307.231 expended out of 474.499) and 72% physical completion. Work is ongoing with satisfactory progress.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Mohmand is nearly complete, with 100% financial utilization (111.00 expended) and 98% physical progress. Minor work remains unfinished.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Swabi shows 32% financial progress (34.76 expended out of 107.350) and 50% physical completion. Physical work is ahead of financial expenditure, indicating potential delays in fund disbursement.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Mardan has utilized 32% of funds (46.02 out of 146.060) but has achieved 80% physical progress, reflecting efficient execution despite lower spending.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz D.I.Khan has reached 37% financial progress (40.67 expended out of 111.380) and 60% physical completion. Progress is steady but requires closer monitoring.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Haripur lags behind, with only 29% financial progress (42.47 out of 148.430) and 40% physical completion. Accelerated efforts are needed to meet targets.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz South Waziristan Lower is the slowest, with 22% financial progress (37.62 out of 171.062) and 35% physical completion. Immediate intervention is required to expedite work.





#### **District Mohmand:**

The construction of Jawan Markaz Mohmand has achieved 98% physical completion with full utilization of the allocated Rs. 111.00 million budget. The project is currently in its final phase of completion, with only minor finishing works remaining before operationalization.



#### **District Swabi:**

The Sub-Divisional Officer (SDO) and the Assistant Director from the Directorate of Works, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, along with the contractor and District Youth Officer Swabi, Mr. Shahzeb, visited Jawan Markaz Swabi for a detailed inspection of the ongoing construction. The officials carefully examined all aspects of the work, and a comprehensive inspection report will be submitted shortly by the concerned authorities.



#### **Grand Youth Complex Peshawar:**

Construction on the Grand Youth Complex in Peshawar is 85% complete. This facility will be a central hub for youth activities in the region.





#### **District Mardan:**

Significant progress has been made at Jawan Markaz Mardan. Tiles and flooring work have been completed, and electrification work is currently underway. The ongoing activities are being monitored to ensure that all work meets the required quality standards.



#### District D.I.Khan

The construction work of Jawan Markaz D.I. Khan is progressing smoothly, with around 50% of the structure completed. The brick walls and support pillars are already in place, and construction materials are available on-site. The project team is actively working to ensure its timely completion.



#### **District Abbottabad**

Land for Jawan Markaz Abbottabad has been secured, and construction planning is being carried out. Preparations for foundational work and site development are being made to ensure that construction can proceed smoothly once it begins.





#### **District Haripur:**

Electrification on the ground floor has been completed and plastering and tiling are scheduled to commence next week in JM Haripur. On the upper floor, minor cosmetic adjustments and pending tasks remain, after which electrification and other activities will continue. Currently, work on the upper floor bathrooms is underway.



#### **District South Waziristan Lower:**

Construction at Jawan Markaz South Waziristan (Lower) is currently progressing steadily. Plaster work on the ground floor is being carried out, while the first-floor beams have been completed and brickwork is being done. The site was jointly inspected along with the Site Engineer to ensure that all work is meeting the required quality standards.



#### **District Buner:**

The construction of Jawan Markaz Buner is progressing well, with the main walls now standing and the structural framework taking shape. This marks a significant step toward completion, as upcoming work will focus on roof preparation, plastering and interior development to transform the structure into a functional youth facility.

#### Orakzai, Khurram and North Waziristan: Land Acquired

Land for Jawan Marakiz in these districts has been acquired. These centers are expected to deliver much-needed infrastructure to empower the youth in these regions.

#### **Temporary and Permanent Jawan Marakiz: Ongoing Progress**

Temporary rented buildings are being used to house Jawan Marakiz in some districts while permanent facilities are under construction. Across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, significant progress is being made on permanent Jawan Marakiz, providing hope and empowerment to the youth in these regions.


#### Upper Chitral, Upper Dir, Shangala, Karak, Bannu, Kohat, Malakand


