
## EHSAAKS NAUJAWAN PROGRAMME



**PROJECT DESIGN:**

The Ehsaas Naujawan program offers interest-free loans through two distinct components, each tailored to different financing needs to promote youth entrepreneurship and economic self-sufficiency in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

**COMPONENT-I: BANK OF KHYBER (1.0 - 5.0 MILLION PKR)-  
(TOTAL COST: 1.0 BILLION)**

This component targets the youth (aged 18-35 years) through a cluster approach, wherein the cluster of three to five youth individuals applies for the loan by signing an Association of Partnership (AOP). The approach aims to support entrepreneurs seeking larger capital to launch or expand their medium-scale businesses, especially in high potential sectors, promoting team work and enhancing the business with diverse expertise through equal partnership.

The loans under this component are disbursed through Bank of Khyber, interest free loans ranging from 1.0 to 5.0 million PKR are provided to the youth with an easy repayment schedule of 96 months (eight years) and an initial 20 months as a grace period (no repayment required). Applicants must submit viable business plans online through Ehsaas Naujawan portal, and loans are offered to those applicants who demonstrate sustainable business model with growth potential.

**COMPONENT-II: AKHUWAT MICROFINANCE BANK (0.1 - 0.5 MILLION PKR) -  
(TOTAL COST: 2.0 BILLION)**

This component offers smaller loans, ranging from 0.1 to 0.5 million PKR to the individuals aged 18-40

years, to start small businesses or microenterprises. Provided by Akhuwat Microfinance Bank, these loans are accessible to youth from marginalized or low-income backgrounds. This component emphasizes financial inclusion, allowing young individuals to gain a foothold in the economy through manageable, interest-free financing for small-scale entrepreneurial activities.

To ensure inclusivity, the programme has set aside a special quota of 15% for young women, along with a 2.5% quota for youth with special abilities, 5 % for madaris youth, and 2.5% for minorities. Funds for loan are distributed equitably among districts based on their population size, ensuring that each district receives support proportional to its needs.

**UPDATED STATUS OF THE PROGRAMME (as of 08-Dec-2025):**

As per the latest report communicated by the Implementing Partners i.e. Bank of Khyber and Akhuwat Islamic Microfinance (AIM), the Ehsaas Naujawan Programme continues to demonstrate strong operational performance and substantial youth engagement across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

**Under Component-I**, a total of **14,618** applications have been received. Of these, **321** applications have been approved for financing, amounting to **PKR 717 million** in approved loan amounts. To date, **234** clusters (each comprising 3–5 youth members) have received disbursements totalling **PKR 592 million**, directly benefiting **215 male and 19 female** entrepreneurs, along with **9 madaris** youth beneficiaries. The recovered amount by Bok is **PKR 2.9 million** which will be revolved. Currently, **261 applications remain in the pipeline for processing**, with **PKR 83 million** still available for further disbursement under this component.

**For Component-II**, administered by Akhuwat Microfinance, **9,069** applications have been submitted, with a high approval rate resulting in **5,928** sanctioned applications. The total approved amount under this window is **PKR 1,094.9 million**, which has been fully disbursed to all approved beneficiaries. This component has particularly emphasized inclusivity, benefiting **5,612 male and 316 female applicants**, as well as 5 individuals from minority communities. Repayment collection remains robust, with **PKR 193.5 million** already recovered. An additional **1,912 applications** are currently being processed, though the allocated funds under this component have been fully utilized.

Collectively, the ENP has received **23,687** applications across both components, with **6,249** approvals leading to the disbursement of **PKR 1,686.9 million** to **6,162** youth beneficiaries. The programme maintains a strong forward pipeline of **2,173** applications in various stages of processing.

This updated status underscores the programme's sustained reach, efficient fund utilization, and continued demand among the youth of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

# Jawan Marakiz Status

## Statement Report on Youth Development Schemes Progress

- The following is a consolidated statement on the financial and physical progress of various youth development schemes:
- Upgradation of Battakundi Youth Hostel (Phase-I) has been completed with 100% financial and physical progress. The total cost of 33.00 has been fully utilized.
- Construction of Peshawar Youth Complex has achieved 64% financial progress (307.231 expended out of 474.499) and 72% physical completion. Work is ongoing with satisfactory progress.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Mohmand is nearly complete, with 100% financial utilization (111.00 expended) and 98% physical progress. Minor work remains unfinished.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Swabi shows 32% financial progress (34.76 expended out of 107.350) and 50% physical completion. Physical work is ahead of financial expenditure, indicating potential delays in fund disbursement.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Mardan has utilized 32% of funds (46.02 out of 146.060) but has achieved 80% physical progress, reflecting efficient execution despite lower spending.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz D.I.Khan has reached 37% financial progress (40.67 expended out of 111.380) and 60% physical completion. Progress is steady but requires closer monitoring.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz Haripur lags behind, with only 29% financial progress (42.47 out of 148.430) and 40% physical completion. Accelerated efforts are needed to meet targets.
- Construction of Jawan Markaz South Waziristan Lower is the slowest, with 22% financial progress (37.62 out of 171.062) and 35% physical completion. Immediate intervention is required to expedite work.
