## REPORT ON JAWAN MARAKIZ STATUS ACROSS KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA



### **District Mohmand:**

The construction of Jawan Markaz Mohmand has achieved 98% physical completion with full utilization of the allocated Rs. 111.00 million budget. The project is currently in its final phase of completion, with only minor finishing works remaining before operationalization.



### **District Swabi:**
