encourage innovation, and strengthen small and medium

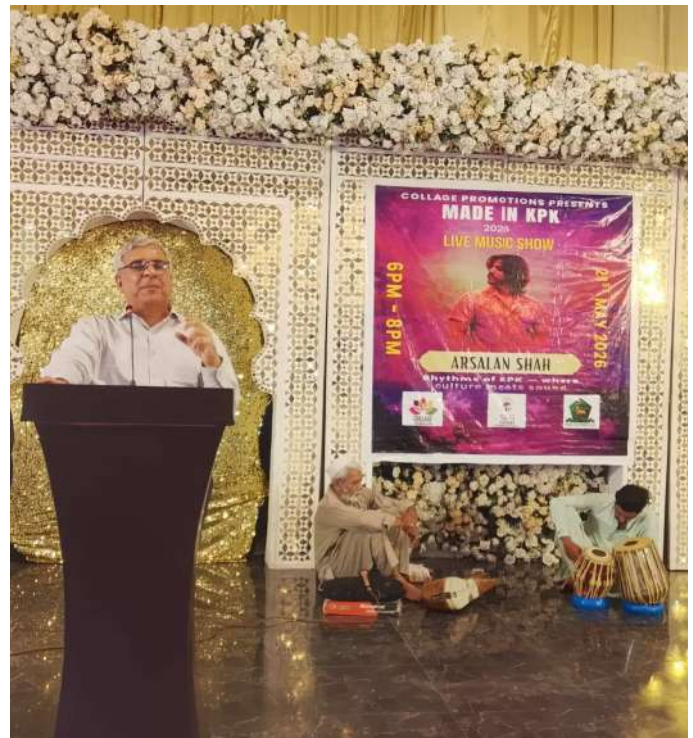
enterprises (SMEs).The event was attended by representatives from
