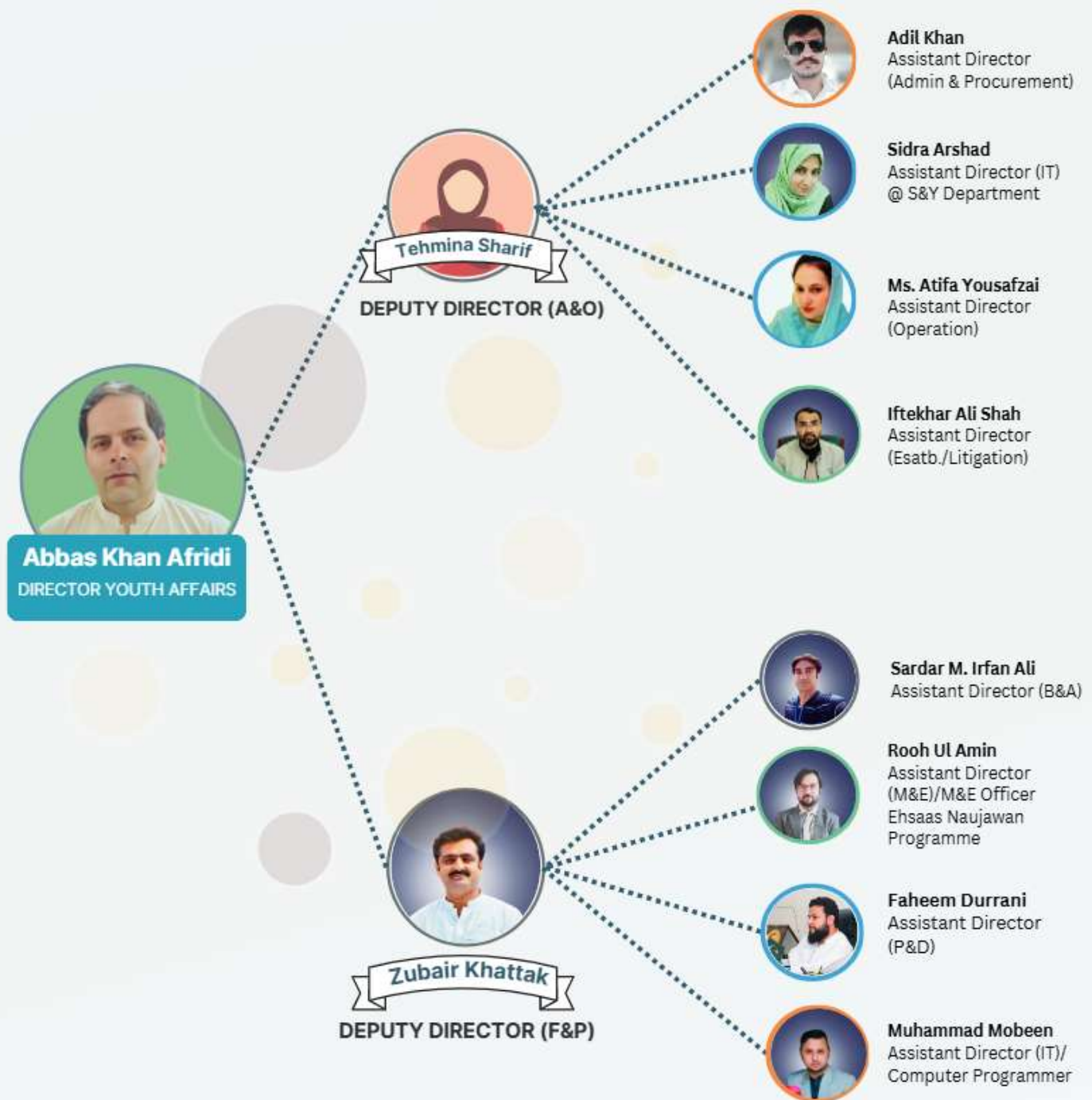

Ongoing Projects

1. YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE

The Youth Development Package is an endeavor, designed to equip young people with the skills, resources, and opportunities necessary to thrive in today's dynamic landscape. Through various capacity-building programs, vocational training initiatives, and entrepreneurial support schemes, this project seeks to unlock the potential of the youth population, enabling them to contribute meaningfully to society and the economy.

2. ESTABLISHMENT OF JAWAN MARAKIZ

Additionally, the Directorate is actively involved in the establishment and operationalization of Youth Facilities (Jawan Markaz) across the settled and Merged Districts (MDs). This includes the establishment of new Jawan Markaz in Bannu, Charsadda, Upper Chitral, Kohat, Shangla, Battagram, Mansehra, Lakki Marwat, Karak, and Lower Dir, while the Jawan Markaz at Mohmand, Mardan, and Dera Ismail Khan (DI Khan) have been completed and are ready for operation. Construction of the Jawan Markaz at Swabi is currently in progress. In addition, the Directorate is implementing the project "Procurement of Revenue Items for 06 Newly Constructed Jawan Marakiz" to equip the newly established facilities with the essential furniture, office equipment, IT infrastructure, library resources, and other operational items required to make them fully functional. Recognizing the unique challenges and opportunities faced by youth across these districts, these initiatives aim to provide modern youth-friendly infrastructure, including educational resources, entrepreneurship development and incubation booths, IT labs, digital libraries, career counseling centers, microfinance facilities, district youth convention centers, and recreational amenities. Together, these efforts seek to create inclusive spaces where young people can connect, learn, develop skills, foster innovation, and enhance their socio-economic opportunities.

3. EHSAAS NAUJAWAN PROGRAMME

The Directorate successfully launched the Ehsaas Noujawan Rozgar Scheme, a transformative initiative aimed at enhancing youth engagement and promoting enterprise development. The scheme, inaugurated by Chief Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Mr. Ali Amin Khan Gandapur, on 7th November 2024, has since gained momentum through collaborative partnerships, innovative training modules and targeted interventions.

4. THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PROVINCIAL YOUTH POLICY & YOUTH PROMOTIONAL ACTIVITIES IN KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA

The Implementation of Provincial Youth Policy & Youth Promotional Activities in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa is a flagship initiative reflected in the ADP 2026-27, aimed at strengthening structured youth engagement across the province. The project focuses on translating the vision of the Youth Policy into practical outcomes through skill development programs, leadership training, entrepreneurship support, awareness campaigns, and community-based activities. It is designed to create sustainable opportunities for young people, enhance their participation in socio-economic development, and ensure effective coordination between government institutions and youth at the grassroots level.

Each Jawan Markaz will be equipped with a modern IT laboratory, a fully equipped auditorium, training and conference halls, study and library facilities, career guidance and counseling services, along with other contemporary amenities. These facilities will provide young people with an enabling environment to learn, innovate, collaborate, and realize their full potential.

This significant investment reflects the Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's strong commitment to empowering youth by expanding access to quality learning opportunities, digital resources, and professional development. The initiative aims to prepare young people to become productive, skilled, and responsible citizens who can make meaningful contributions to the social and economic development of the province.

Jawan Markaz is more than an infrastructure project—it is an investment in the future of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, creating centers of excellence where the next generation of leaders, innovators, entrepreneurs, and skilled professionals will be nurtured.

MADE IN KPK CLUSTER SME EXPO 2026

The Directorate of Youth Affairs KP supported the Made in KPK Cluster SME Expo held at Galaxy Hall Peshawar on May 20–21, 2026. PEAK 2026 SUMMIT

YOUTH POLICY 2026 APPROVED IN PRINCIPLE: A NEW VISION FOR THE YOUTH OF KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA

A YOUTHFUL KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA. A PROSPEROUS KHYBER PAKHTUNKHWA!



In a high-level meeting of the Sports and Youth Affairs Department chaired by Muhammad Sohail Khan Afridi, the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Youth Policy 2026 was approved in principle. The policy will be submitted to the Provincial Cabinet for final approval.

To strengthen youth empowerment and safeguard the rights of young people, the Chief Minister directed that dedicated legislation be introduced and approved the establishment of Jawan Markaz (Youth Centers) in every district of the province. Empowered local governing bodies will also be constituted to ensure the effective management and sustainability of these centers.

The Chief Minister emphasized that since a significant proportion of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa's population comprises young people, investing in youth is both essential and strategic. He announced that the FY 2026–27 budget will be a "Youth Budget," with digital skills development identified as one of the Government's highest priorities. Under the Youth Policy 2026, more than PKR 7 billion will be invested over the next two years to support youth development across the province. The policy is built around four core pillars:

- Education
- Employment
- Environment
- Social Inclusion

Key Features of the Youth Policy 2026

- Universal access to secondary education, particularly for girls, and expanded opportunities for higher education.
- Scholarships, training programmes, mobile outreach services in rural and merged districts, and the establishment of Jawan Markaz for young women.
- Inclusive support for persons with disabilities, employment assistance for transgender youth, and reserved opportunities for minority youth.
- Alignment of technical and vocational education with market needs, alongside the promotion of modern digital skills.
- Youth internship programmes in both the public and private sectors, expanded employment opportunities, and entrepreneurship support for young innovators.
- Establishment of Provincial and District Youth Councils and youth volunteer groups to encourage community engagement.
- Promotion of digital transformation, youth-friendly governance, and initiatives for youth health and well-being.
- Activation of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Youth Development Commission and the establishment of a Youth Development Fund.

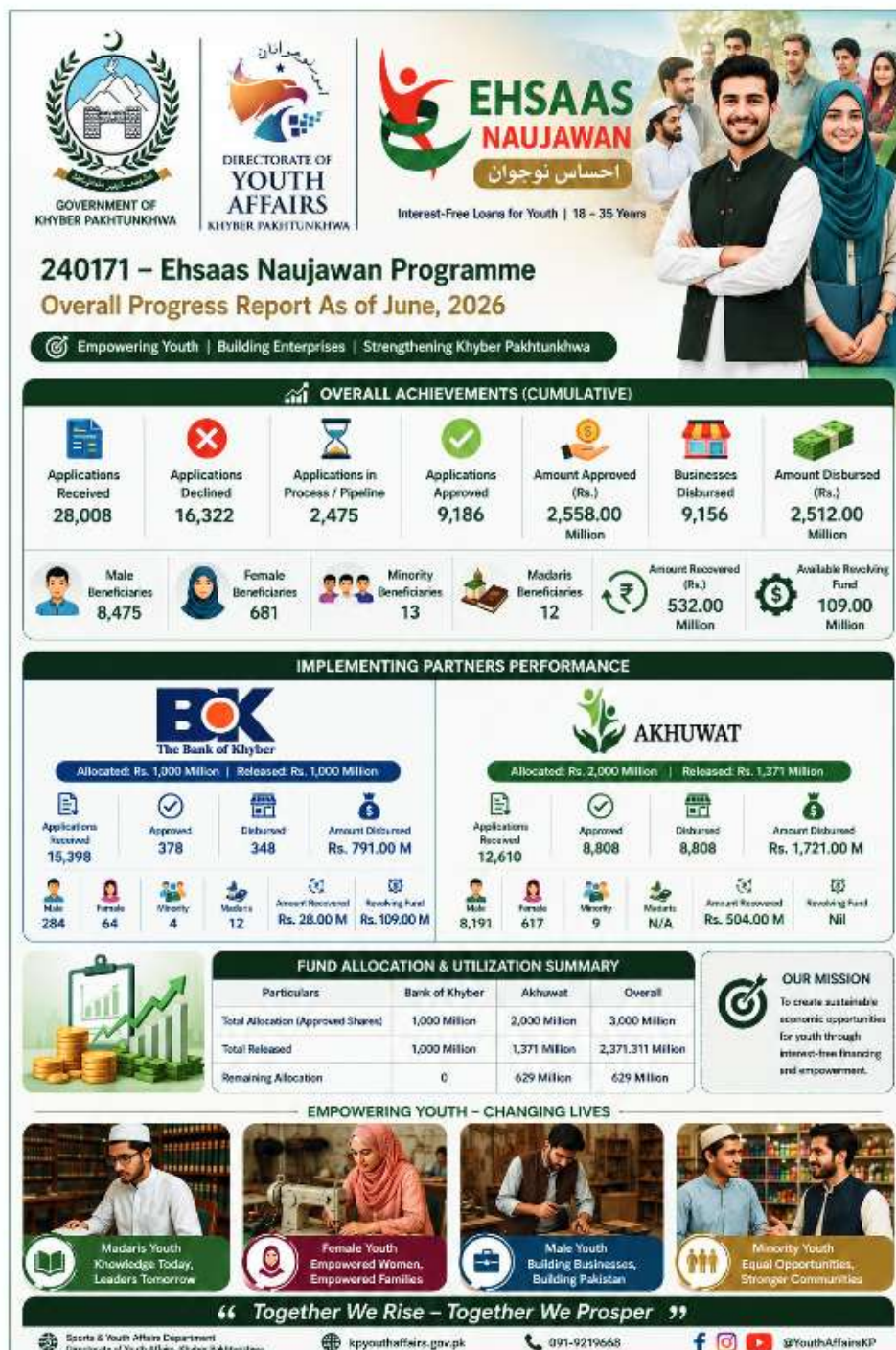

EBAY E-COMMERCE COURSE SUCCESSFULLY CONCLUDES UNDER DOT 2.0 IN CHARSADDA

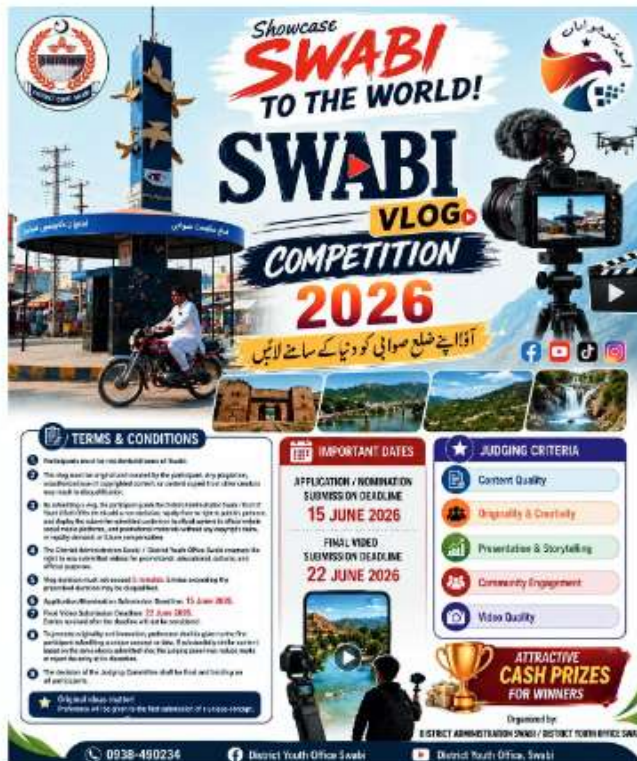

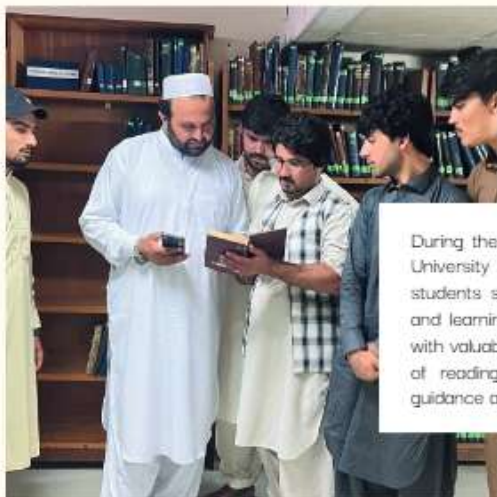
The students also visited Quaid-i-Azam University Islamabad, where they were briefed on modern library systems and research facilities, followed by a recreational visit to Lake View Park.

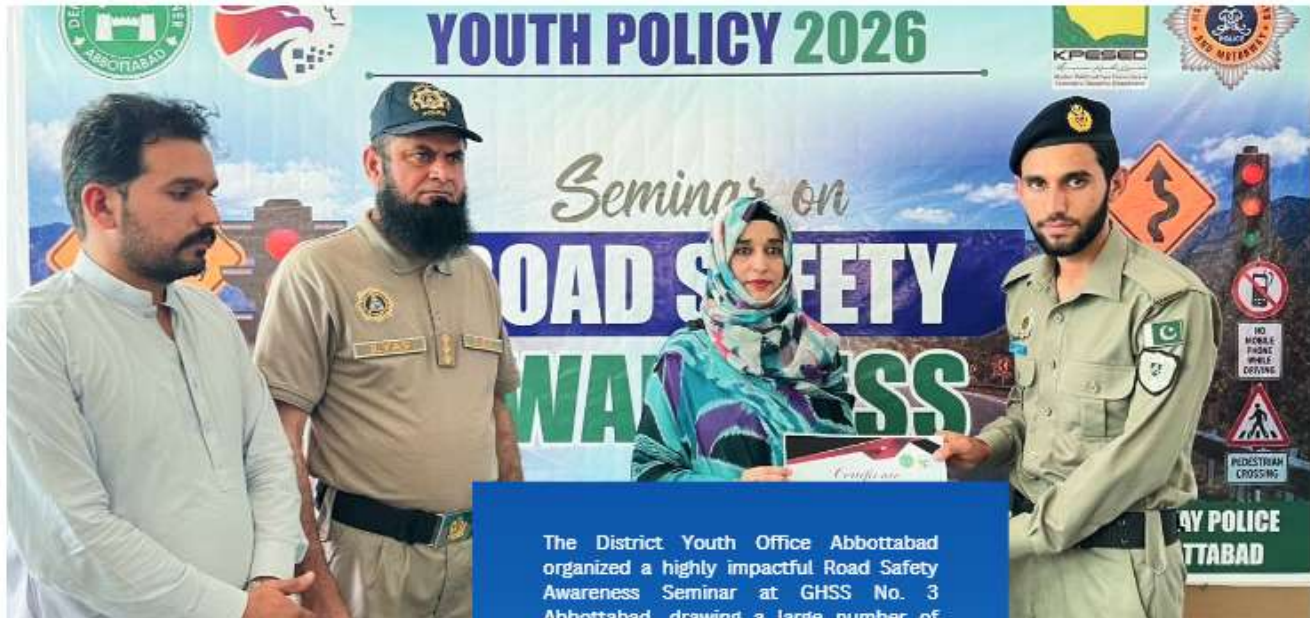

Road Safety Awareness Seminar Held in Abbottabad



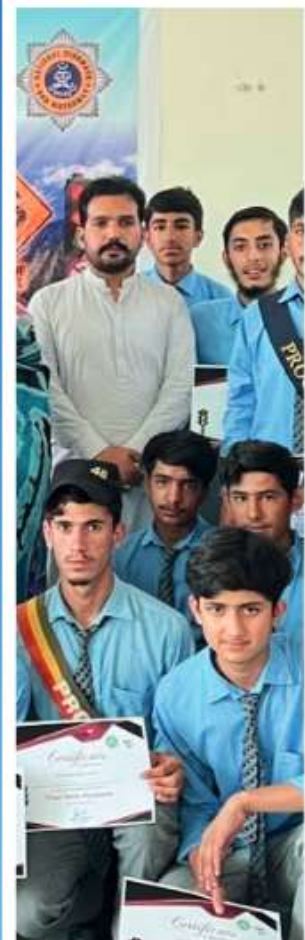

Land for Jawan Marakiz in these districts has been acquired. These centers are expected to deliver much-needed infrastructure to empower the youth in these regions.

Temporary and Permanent Jawan Marakiz: Ongoing Progress

Temporary rented buildings are being used to house Jawan Marakiz in some districts while permanent facilities are under construction. Across Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, significant progress is being made on permanent Jawan Marakiz, providing hope and empowerment to the youth in these regions.

Land Acquisition Initiate In these districts, land has been identified for the construction of Jawan Marakiz, and the land acquisition process has begun. This marks the first step in creating youth-focused centers in these areas.
