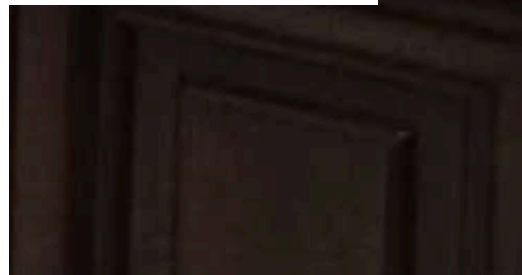

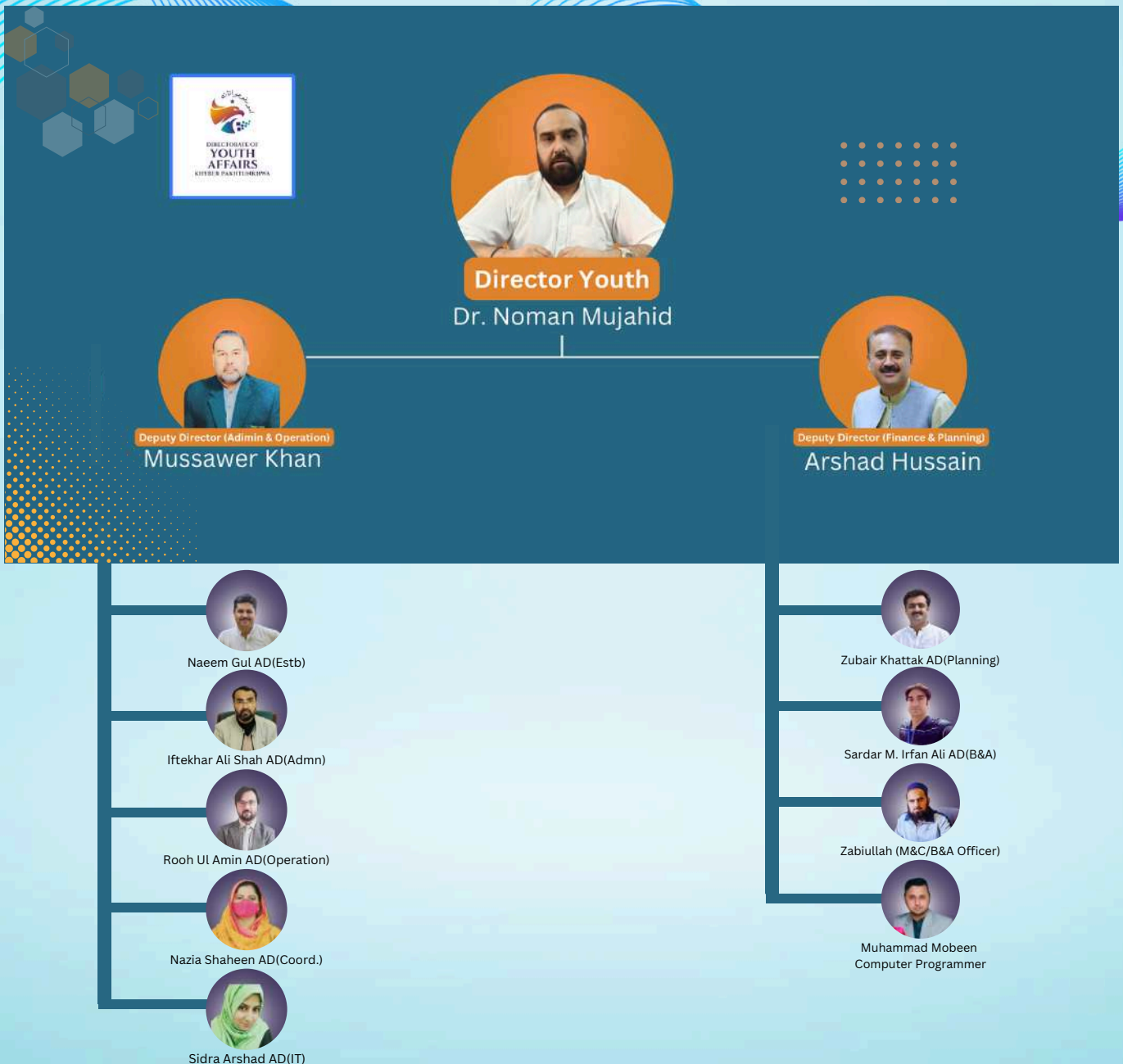

YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PACKAGE

The Youth Development Package is an endeavor, designed to equip young people with the skills, resources, and opportunities necessary to thrive in today's dynamic landscape. Through various capacity-building programs, vocational training initiatives, and entrepreneurial support schemes, this project seeks to unlock the potential of the youth population, enabling them to contribute meaningfully to society and the economy



ESTABLISHMENT OF JAWAN MARAKIZ

Additionally, the Directorate is actively involved in the establishment of Youth Facilities in settled and Merged Districts (MDs) and in recognition of the unique challenges and opportunities faced by youth in the districts. By providing essential infrastructure, educational resources, entrepreneurship development and incubation boots, IT Labs, Digital Library, Career counseling centers, Microfinancing facility, District youth convention centers and recreational amenities, this initiative aims to create inclusive spaces where young people can connect, learn, and grow.



NEW PROJECTS

Looking ahead, the Directorate is poised to launch the Youth Cluster Soft Loan Program / Ehsas Nojawan Rozgar Scheme, a pioneering initiative to bolster youth engagement and enterprise development further. Through collaborative partnerships, innovative training modules, and targeted interventions, this program seeks to harness the collective potential of youth clusters, fostering innovation, competitiveness, and sustainable growth.



Directorate Events / Meetings

On June 14, 2024, the Advisor to the Chief Minister of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa on Sports and Youth Affairs, Syed Fakhar Jehan, met with the delegation of students from UET Mardan. The students presented the project of aerial firing detecting machine developed by them which can detect the location of aerial firing within a one-kilometer radius. During the meeting, the Advisor acknowledged the work of the students and awarded them with a cash prize of Rs. 100,000 for their excellent work.



On June 10, Syed Fakhr Jehan, Advisor to the Chief Minister KP for Sports and Youth Affairs, Progress Review Meeting with DYOs.

The Advisor reviewed the work of District Youth Officers and directed the officers to avoid low-impact activities and emphasis should be on the activities addressing the socio-economic issues for which a diversified approach may be adopted to mitigate unemployment by offering skills and entrepreneurship development training alongwith career counseling, digital skills, and e-commerce literacy to the youth. Furthermore, the DYOs were instructed to arrange youth festivals at the district level which should be both academic, cultural, and recreational.



On June 27, 2024, the Director Youth Affairs chaired a meeting with multiple stakeholders to discuss the Ehsas Nojawan Rozgar Scheme online platform for KP youth. It was decided that KPITB will develop online portal with technical assistance of the Bank of Khyber (BoK). The Bank of Khyber will develop the general instruction regarding eligibility of the loans along with required documentation for the online portal along with branding and communications, and CM Secretariat will design the logo and videos.

The prisoners participated in various sports, showcasing their skills and reminding us that everyone deserves a chance to enjoy and express themselves, no matter where they are.

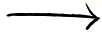

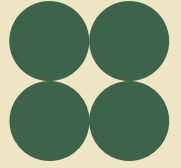
